

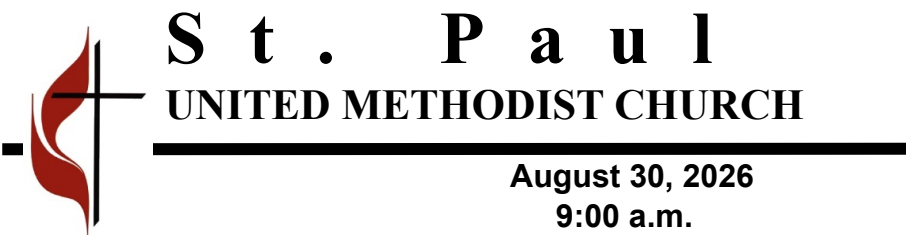
Our Vision
