Vacation Bible School – July 8 -12

Are you ready for summer?? We are getting ready to embark on our next Vacation Bible School here at St. Paul! This year's theme is "SCUBA" where children will dive into a deeper friendship with God.

SCUBA VBS will run from July 8-12. VBS starts at 9:00 each morning and concludes at 11:30 am. Children must be at least 5 years old to attend. Children up through fifth grade may register. Youth students currently enrolled in grades 6-12 may sign up to help as station assistants.

We need ADULTS to help serve in the following capacities:

1. Crew leaders: NO TEACHING involved! You will have a small group of children assigned to you. You will guide your children from station to station and participate in the various activities and discussions with them. This is a GREAT chance to not only build positive relationships with children, but to share your faith and the good news of the Gospel. You would need to be present no later than 8:45 to meet children as they start to arrive. You will be done around 11:30 am after all the children in your group have been picked up.

2. VBS set and classroom decorating will take place on Sunday, July 7 starting at 11:00 am in the FLC. If you can stay to help, please do! We'll order pizza and get the main set in place. Many hands make light work. 😊
